Details

The National Information Exchange Model (NIEM) was introduced in 2005 to support the development of standards and processes for sharing information across jurisdictional boundaries. It provides a framework and common vocabulary which can be exploited to facilitate data exchange in both emergency and day-to-day operations. The Treasury Board of Canada has expressed interest in NIEM. The Emergency Management and System Integration (EMSI) project beginning in April, will be examining the NIEM in more detail.

The IJIS was established as a not-for-profit corporation by the Industry Working Group and is funded in part through grants from the US Department of Justice and US Department of Homeland Security. Arrangements have been made for the IJIS to conduct a NIEM Practical Implementer's Course in Ottawa on May 12-14, 2009.

NIEM consists of reusable components that enable information exchange and reuse in multiple applications and sources. The standardization of the components results in increased interoperability from data exchanges between various information systems. This technical course is specifically designed for implementers, developers, and practitioners in the field. Prior XML experience is recommended. This new and improved implementer's course is designed to provide 24 hours of training, presented over three days. The course includes hands-on exercises and case studies and students are provided course material in hard and soft copy. Additionally, a list of available resources and contact information is distributed to provide students with post-training support.
