- Gulfstream G550 full-flight simulator (FFS) entered service in April

CAE Vienna complements the pilot and aircraft maintenance technician training delivered at CAE Burgess Hill in the United Kingdom.

"We were very excited to welcome Alexander Vagacs, Chairman of Avcon Jet, as our first customer at CAE Vienna. Alexander has trained with us for 25 years, and since founding Avcon Jet in 2007, we are proud to say that he has also entrusted the training of his pilots to CAE," added Prévost. "Having simulators in Vienna is a fantastic step because, as a company based in Vienna, this gives easy access for our pilots and our crews to training here in Central Europe," commented Alexander Vagacs, Chairman of Avcon Jet, one of Europe's major business aviation companies operating 100 aircraft worldwide. "It makes training much, much easier."
