# Asian Aviation Centre of Excellence (AACE) inaugurates new A330 CAE 7000XR Series full-flight simulator

The simulator is the highest generation simulator in the world, installed by CAE in Malaysia. Enhanced features include a re-designed instructor office with support for mobile devices and real-time data analysis and feedback. The CAE 7000XR Series is also equipped with embedded training capabilities to address Upset Prevention and Recovery Training (UPRT).

The new CAE 7000XR Series FFS has been accredited and certified by DCA Malaysia and also the Korea Office of Civil Aviation (KOCA).
