CAE extends Multi-Crew Pilot License (MPL) First Officer Program with Japan Airlines

Singapore, August 30, 2016 (NYSE: CAE; TSX: CAE) – CAE announced today at the 2016 Asia Pacific Airline Training Symposium that it has extended the Japan Airlines (JAL) Multi-Crew Pilot License (MPL) First Officer Program for 3 additional years to a total of 10 years, effective until October 2023. Under the renewed agreement, 24 additional cadets will be selected to begin MPL training for the Japanese airline.
