CAE USA expands to new facility in Arkansas

Little Rock, Arkansas, USA, February 18, 2011 – (NYSE: CAE; TSX: CAE) – CAE today announced that CAE USA has expanded its operations in central Arkansas by moving to new facilities in the Wildwood Center in Sherwood.

The new facility was inaugurated today during a ribbon cutting ceremony attended by city officials of Sherwood; Col Mark Czelusta, 314th Air Wing Commander for the United States Air Force; and John Lenyo, President and General Manager, CAE USA.

The facility in Sherwood will house CAE USA staff focused on designing and implementing comprehensive training solutions for military customers in the United States and abroad. CAE USA training solutions staff will perform training needs analysis, training systems design and courseware development. CAE USA also employs staff at Little Rock Air Force Base (AFB) under subcontract to Lockheed Martin to support both the C-130 Aircrew Training System (ATS) and C-130J Maintenance and Aircrew Training System (MATS) programs. In total, CAE USA employs approximately 90 people now in central Arkansas.

“CAE USA is pleased to expand its operations in the Little Rock area to support not only the U.S. Air Force’s C-130 Center of Excellence at Little Rock Air Force Base, but also leverage our expertise in training solutions development to support other U.S. and allied military training programs,” said Lenyo.
