CAE awarded contracts valued at approximately C\$100 million for six full-flight simulators and various upgrades

Paris, France, June 21, 2011 – (NYSE: CAE; TSX: CAE) – CAE today announced at the Paris Air Show that it has sold six CAE 7000 Series Level D full-flight simulators (FFS) to airline customers in Asia, Europe and North America. CAE will provide a Boeing 787 FFS to British Airways, FFSs for the Airbus A330 and Boeing 737NG aircraft to Garuda Indonesia, an FFS for the Airbus A380 aircraft to Skymark Airlines, an Airbus A320 FFS to US Airways and a Boeing 737-800 FFS to an undisclosed North American airline. CAE has also signed contracts with various airlines for upgrades and updates of CAE-built simulators.

The contracts are worth a total of approximately C\$100 million at list prices, and with the sale of a Phenom 100/300 FFS to Embraer-CAE Training Services announced in May, these bring the total number of FFS sales that CAE has announced to date during fiscal year 2012 to seven.

"These airlines come from Asia, Europe and North America, and each one of them has been our customer for many years, some as long as four decades," said Jeff Roberts, CAE's Group President, Civil Simulation Products, Training and Services. "We are pleased that they continue to leverage CAE's technology advantage and our comprehensive portfolio of training solutions to enhance the safety, efficiency and effectiveness of their flight operations."

British Airways

In addition to the B787 FFS, CAE will provide British Airways with a CAE Simfinity™ Integrated Procedures Trainer (IPT) for the Boeing 787 aircraft. The Boeing 787 FFS and IPT will be delivered to British Airways' Cranebank Training Centre at London Heathrow Airport in 2012.

"We are committed to providing our pilots with the best available training equipment to enhance safety and efficiency," said Mike Burtenshaw, General Manager of British Airways Flight Training. "CAE has consistently delivered innovative and reliable full-flight simulators and other training tools to British Airways."

Garuda Indonesia

The A330 and Boeing 737NG FFSs for Garuda Indonesia will include CAE Tropos™-6000 visual systems, and will be ready for training by the end of this year near Soekarno-Hatta International Airport in the Jakarta area.

President and CEO of Garuda Indonesia Emirsyah Satar said that to anticipate the rapid market growing in the industry, Garuda Indonesia had implemented its Quantum Leap program until 2015 where Garuda will operate 153 aircraft, including the A330-200 and Boeing 737-800NG. "The partnership with CAE will help Garuda to fulfill the need for more pilots in time by providing us with a new, highest-quality training environment at our base in Jakarta," Satar said.

Skymark Airlines

The A380 FFS will be delivered to Skymark's main base at Tokyo International Airport in Haneda, Japan in 2012.

US Airways

The A320 FFS will be delivered to US Airways' East Coast Flight Training Center in Charlotte, North Carolina, USA in 2012, and will include a CAE Tropos™-6000 visual system.

"CAE flight simulators present the most realistic training scenarios available and are highly reliable day in and day out."
