This order includes the world's second airline-operated Boeing 777X full-flight simulator (FFS).

The innovative CAE7000XR Series FFSs and CAE 500XR FTDs will be delivered at Qatar Airways' training centre in Doha, Qatar, beginning in 2019. In addition, CAE extended its training centre operations services, to operate and maintain the training equipment suite for the airline for the next 15 years.
