## CAE to launch business aviation and civil helicopter training in Asia this year

Bombardier Global 5000, Global Express, Global Express XRS, Dassault Falcon 7X, Gulfstream G450 / G550 and Sikorsky S-76C++ training programs to be offered in the region

Shanghai, People's Republic of China, March 27, 2012 - CAE (NYSE: CAE; TSX: CAE) announced today at the Asian Business Aviation Conference & Exhibition (ABACE) that it will begin training pilots and maintenance technicians this year for business aircraft and civil helicopter operators in Asia. Gulfstream G450 and G550 training and Sikorsky S-76C++ training will be offered in 2012. Training for the Bombardier\* Global 5000\*, Global Express\* and Global Express XRS\* business aircraft will be available in early 2013. CAE intends to deploy a training program for the Dassault Falcon 7X aircraft soon thereafter; the date will be prescribed by market conditions.

CAE training customers in Asia include Beijing White Bear Business Aviation Corporation, GMR Aviation Pvt. Ltd of India, Shanghai Deer Jet and other business aircraft operators.

"This is CAE's first business aviation and civil helicopter training deployment in Asia, and reaffirms our commitment to deliver world-class training and services convenient to where our customers operate, said Jeff Roberts, CAE Group President, Civil Simulation Products, Training and Services. "This new capability will help support business aviation and civil helicopter growth in Asia by providing the highestquality trained personnel using CAE's market-leading simulation technology and instructional best practices."
