CAE also delivers a range of operational ISR solutions to Canada and the global market, including magnetic anomaly detection for anti-submarine warfare, electronic warfare suites for land forces, and augmented visionics solutions for aircraft navigation in degraded visual environments.

Mr. Greenley brings over 25 years of leadership experience within the Canadian defence and security markets. He comes to CAE from General Dynamics Corporation, where he served as Vice President International, C4 Systems as well as Vice President, Strategy and Development for Canada. Mr. Greenley was previously Vice President of Modelling & Simulation for CAE's Military business unit. Prior to that, he was President of CAE Professional Services and founder of Greenley and Associates, which was acquired by CAE in 2004.

Mr. Greenley currently serves as Chairman of the Board of the Canadian Association of Defence and Security Industries (CADSI) and Chairman of the Advisory Board for Defence and Security Export to the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT) in Canada.
