# Accomodation

The students rooms are located in close proximity of the school and offer a comfortable stay. The rooms are equipped with single beds.

Upon arrival, the rooms are allocated to the students and are to be used exclusively by the assigned users. This means that visitors cannot stay overnight. The rooms have bathrooms with a shower, sink and WC. WiFi is available in the rooms. Each student room has a pantry kitchen equipped with a fridge, an electric hotplate and microwave oven. Moreover, every room has a TV and a desk. You are welcome to bring your own coffee machines or electric kettles.
