- 4) This approval shall remain in force unless suspended or revoked.

Scope of Approval:

- 1) This Design Organization Approval is granted for designing, showing, verifying and demonstrating in accordance with applicable Type Certification basis and environmental protection requirements changes to type design and repairs in the areas and the categories of products indicated in EASA DOA EASA.21J.446.

Privileges/Limitations:

- 1) The holder of the Design Organization Approval shall be entitled to perform design activities for the UAE registered aircraft within scope/limitations of its approval and has same privileges as indicated in EASA DOA EASA.21J.446.
