The total value of the NGA Beyond 3D prototype project, if all options are exercised, is more than US\$37 million.

The Beyond 3D prototype project for NGA will leverage the United States Special Operations Command's (USSOCOM) Automating the Rapid Generation of 3D Geospatial Data (RAPID 3D) prototype and advance the development for broader NGA-specific uses across the Department of Defense and U.S. intelligence agencies. Ultimately, the goal of the Beyond 3D system is to improve NGA's ability to deliver geo-specific, real-world 3D content in real-time to end-user's needing the content for analysis, planning and decision-support.
